Psalm 1

Reading: Psalm 1:1-6

What is the only thing that separates saints and sinner? How does the Bible define “righteousness”?

What does it mean to not draw wisdom from the “counsel of the ungodly”?

True wisdom is only found in one place – where is that?

What does the blessed man do – day and night?

What does “meditation” mean for Christians? What is biblical meditation?

Proverbs 5:15 – *“Drink water from your own cistern and running water from your own well.”*

How does the picture of a fruitful tree connect with a “blessed man”?

The “ungodly” is “like chaff which the wind drives away”, but how are mature grains of wheat different?

Luke 3:16-17 – *“John answered, saying to all, “I indeed baptize you with water; but One mightier than I is coming, whose sandal strap I am not worthy to loose. He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and fire. His winnowing fan is in His hand, and He will thoroughly clean out His threshing floor, and gather the wheat into His barn; but the chaff He will burn with unquenchable fire.”*
