Reading: Psalm 10

Prayer for the Overthrow of the Wicked

In the beginning of Psalm 10 does David sense God's nearness?

As a Christian, may we also find ourselves wondering where God is in the midst of our struggles?

How does David approach God regarding the wicked?

How does the tone of this Psalm say the wicked viewed God? (The Septuagint connects Psalm 9 and 10 so when read together it really conveys the intensity of David's petitions against the wicked).

Do the wicked consult or acknowledge God? It is one thing when the wicked ignores His presence but what about when His children ignore Him?

How does the tone of Psalm 10 progress toward the end?

How may we take comfort in Psalm 10?

Prayer Focus:

Asking God to help us keep our focus on Him Petition the Lord to execute His judgment on evil Verse 16-18
