Psalm 13

Reading: Psalm 13:1-6

God enlightens our eyes and changes us. How does that happen?

God must manifest Himself to us and reveal Himself. Why is it a miracle if we see how great His salvation is?

John 17:6 *“I have manifested Your name to the men whom You have given Me out of the world. They were Yours, You gave them to Me, and they have kept Your word.”*

What are the final enemies that Jesus is going to destroy?

What do we see clearly when our eyes are enlightened to see Jesus?

Revelation 1:13-16 *“the Son of Man, clothed with a garment down to the feet and girded about the chest with a golden band. His head and hair were white like wool, as white as snow, and His eyes like a flame of fire; His feet were like fine brass, as if refined in a furnace, and His voice as the sound of many waters; He had in His right hand seven stars, out of His mouth went a sharp two-edged sword, and His countenance was like the sun shining in its strength.”*

Process this picture of Jesus for a few minutes. If you saw Him like John did – how would you be changed?

Promise to cling to this week: *“But I have trusted in Your mercy; My heart shall rejoice in Your salvation.” (verse 5)*
