Praise and Prayers for Every Day Psalm 13

Reading: Psalm 13:1-6

God enlightens our eyes and changes us. How does that happen?

God must manifest Himself to us and reveal Himself. Why is it a miracle if we see how great His salvation is?

John 17:6 "I have manifested Your name to the men whom You have given Me out of the world. They were Yours, You gave them to Me, and they have kept Your word."

What are the final enemies that Jesus is going to destroy?

What do we see clearly when our eyes are enlightened to see Jesus?

Revelation 1:13-16 "the Son of Man, clothed with a garment down to the feet and girded about the chest with a golden band. His head and hair were white like wool, as white as snow, and His eyes like a flame of fire; His feet were like fine brass, as if refined in a furnace, and His voice as the sound of many waters; He had in His right hand seven stars, out of His mouth went a sharp two-edged sword, and His countenance was like the sun shining in its strength."

Process this picture of Jesus for a few minutes. If you saw Him like John did – how would you be changed?

Promise to cling to this week: "But I have trusted in Your mercy; My heart shall rejoice in Your salvation." (verse 5)
