Praise and Prayers for Every Day Psalm 18

Reading: Psalm 18:4-6, 16-19, 31-36, 46

(Please try to read the full Psalm but because of the length we will be focusing only on these verses for the teaching.)

When the "floods of ungodliness" make us afraid – what should be our response?

Why should we acknowledge the power of our "strong enemy"? How does knowing God is stronger help us set other people free?

What is the motivation and heart of God to bring deliverance to His children?

What does humility and dependence on God come from in our lives? What do we need to understand?

Luke 7:47 "Therefore I say to you, her sins, which are many, are forgiven, for she loved much. But to whom little is forgiven, the same loves little."

How does God "make our feet like deer's feet" and keep us from falling down if we walk with Him?

I John 4:4 "You are of God, little children, and have overcome them, because He who is in you is greater than he who is in the world."

Promise to cling to this week: "He also brought me out into a broad place; He delivered me because He delighted in me." (verse 19)
