Psalm 26

Reading: Psalm 26:1-12

Are there injustices that happen even to believers in Jesus on this earth – in this fallen world?

What does the word "Vindicate" mean?

When we realize that the "rain falls on the just and the unjust" – how does that give us comfort?

How should we respond to injustices? What did David and Job do when they faced suffering?

Job 19:25-26 – "For I know that my Redeemer lives, And He shall stand at last on the earth; And after my skin is destroyed, this I know, That in my flesh I shall see God."

How can the Body of Christ provide stability and an "even place" to us in times of suffering and injustice?

Romans 8:18 – "For I consider that the sufferings of this present time are not worthy to be compared with the glory which shall be revealed in us."

Promise to cling to this week: "My foot stands in an even place; In the congregations I will bless the Lord." (verse 12)
