Psalm 26

Reading: Psalm 26:1-12

Are there injustices that happen even to believers in Jesus on this earth – in this fallen world?

What does the word “*Vindicate*” mean?

When we realize that the “*rain falls on the just and the unjust*” – how does that give us comfort?

How should we respond to injustices? What did David and Job do when they faced suffering?

Job 19:25-26 – *“For I know that my Redeemer lives,
And He shall stand at last on the earth;
And after my skin is destroyed, this I know,
That in my flesh I shall see God.”*

How can the Body of Christ provide stability and an “*even place*” to us in times of suffering and injustice?

Romans 8:18 – *“For I consider that the sufferings of this present time are not worthy to be compared with the glory which shall be revealed in us.”*

Promise to cling to this week: *“My foot stands in an even place;
In the congregations I will bless the Lord.”* (verse 12)
