Psalm 28

Reading: Psalm 28:1-9

What was David's expectations concerning God's response to the wicked and the righteous?

Knowing God will Shepherd and bless him – came from a place of worship. What did David do to demonstrate that worship?

How can a night of worship or a place of abiding in Christ bring us into revelation of His goodness and His nearness? What kind of impact can a simple SONG – giving God our song – impact our hearts?

Song of Solomon 2:16 - "My beloved is mine, and I am his. He feeds his flock among the lilies."

Hebrews 7:25 - "Therefore He is also able to save to the uttermost those who come to God through Him, since He always lives to make intercession for them."

We are NOT one of the wicked that gets what we deserve. We are "His anointed". How do we get the righteousness of God?

Promise to cling to this week: "The Lord is their strength, And He is the saving refuge of His anointed" (verse 8)
