### Psalm 28

#### Reading: Psalm 28:1-9

What was David's expectations concerning God's response to the wicked and the righteous?

Knowing God will Shepherd and bless him – came from a place of worship. What did David do to demonstrate that worship?

How can a night of worship or a place of abiding in Christ bring us into revelation of His goodness and His nearness? What kind of impact can a simple SONG – giving God our song – impact our hearts?

**Song of Solomon 2:16** - *"My beloved is mine, and I am his. He feeds his flock among the lilies."*

**Hebrews 7:25** - *"Therefore He is also able to save to the uttermost those who come to God through Him, since He always lives to make intercession for them."*

We are NOT one of the wicked that gets what we deserve. We are *"His anointed"*. How do we get the righteousness of God?

**Promise to cling to this week:** *"The Lord is their strength, And He is the saving refuge of His anointed" (verse 8)*
