Praise and Prayers for Every Day Psalm 33

Reading: Psalm 33:1-22

When the foundations of our nation look like they are unraveling – what does God call us to?

How does reading Psalm 33:8-12 that the "counsel of the Lord stands forever" give us comfort and hope for the future?

God sees the earth in two ways – collective nations and individual lives. Why should that matter to our lives?

What does it mean that "He fashions their hearts individually"? How does God know our individual hearts?

1 Peter 2:9-10 - "But you are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, His own special people, that you may proclaim the praises of Him who called you out of darkness into His marvelous light, who once were not a people but are now the people of God, who had not obtained mercy but now has obtained mercy."
