Praise and Prayers for Every Day Psalm 34

Reading: Psalm 34:1-22

What circumstances were happening in David's life when he wrote this Psalm?

What happens to us when we bless the Lord individually or together in unity?

When we feel hunger and lack in our lives – how does God fill us up, spiritually, mentally, and physically?

What are some of the characteristics of a person who wants to live simply, peacefully, and experience deep happiness?

Romans 12:18 - "If it is possible, as much as depends on you, live peaceably with all men."

How do the "eyes" of the Lord show intimacy toward us, even the "ears" of the Lord hearing our cry reveal His heart toward us? Why is the face of the Lord turned away from the wicked?

Promise to cling to this week: "The Lord redeems the soul of His servants, And none of those who trust in Him shall be condemned." (verse 22)
