Praise and Prayers for Every Day

Psalm 38

Reading: Psalm 38:1-22

Why do we need to see our sins and our need for God?

What is the value in using the law to confront people before we give them grace?

Romans 7:18 – *“For I know that in me (that is, in my flesh) nothing good dwells; for to will is present with me, but how to perform what is good I do not find.”*

How do people get confused and think they need to stay in Romans 7 without moving into the freedom of God in Romans 8?

Romans 8:12-15 - *“Therefore, brethren, we are debtors—not to the flesh, to live according to the flesh. For if you live according to the flesh you will die; but if by the Spirit you put to death the deeds of the body, you will live. For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, these are sons of God. For you did not receive the spirit of bondage again to fear, but you received the Spirit of adoption by whom we cry out, “Abba Father.”*

What does Romans 6:14 say about sin’s dominion in the life of the believer in Jesus?

Promise to cling to this week: *“For in You, O Lord, I hope; You will hear, O Lord my God.”* (verse 15)
