Psalm 49

Reading: Psalm 49:1-20

Promise to cling to this week: "Those who trust in their wealth and boast in the multitude of their riches, none of them can by any means redeem his brother, nor give to God a ransom for him—For the redemption of their souls is costly, and it shall cease forever—That he should continue to live eternally, and not see the Pit." (verses 6-9)
