## Praise and Prayers for Every Day

## Psalm 5

Reading: Psalm 5:1-12

Are you a morning person? Even if you are not—do you still see the benefit of seeking God in the morning?

What does prayer look like for you? How are you prioritizing God and making talking to God happen in your spiritual life?

Why is it so important for all of us to be HEARD? Why does knowing that God hears us give us so much identity?

**Psalm 121:1-2** – "I will lift up my eyes to the hills— From whence comes my help? My help comes from the LORD, Who made heaven and earth."
